"Creating Awareness among Parents of Children with Disabilities about Special Education Services through Training Program"

The purpose of the study is to identify the level to awareness among parents of children with Intellectual Disabilities about special Education Service Katked Mandal (District) Karauli, Rajasthan. A total No. of 50 parents (45 Male, Female 5) working in rural area Rajasthan participated in the study. A tool was developed to find out the level awareness among parent of children with Intellectual Disabilities about special education services. To find out the level of awareness of special education services mean percentages was calculated. T-Test was carried out to find out whether there is any significant difference in the level of awareness of special education services as mental retardation reference to gender, age, education and family type. However when compared to the awareness level of mental retardation. The results of the study indicate that there is no significant difference with reference to age, Gender, family type, awareness on intellectual Disability and special education services.

The purpose of special education is to provide special services to people with special needs as they need special attention through specially designed materials teaching. These exceptional children are children with mental retardation, visual impairment, hearing impairment, mental illness and children with learning disabilities

Conducted a study on parental knowledge involvement and satisfaction with their child special education services 'the purpose of this study was to determine level of parental knowledge of P L-94-142 participation in special educating related activities and satisfaction with special education services. In a school district the questionnaire contained item concerning parent knowledge of PL 92-142 right and procedures. Parental participation and involvement in special education related activity and parental satisfaction with special education services 20 parents responded to the questionnaire 16% the sample primarily consisted to Caucasian mothers the result indicated that responded knowledge able about procedure and provision of PL92-142. Highly involved in their Childs special education services.

2. Fiterald, L J and Watkins, W.M (2006)

To make informed educational decisions, parents must be able to read and comprehend the information that is given to them by their school the purpose of the study was to examine the readability of parent's right document of {50} all stets, fifty parents right document were included in the study, which are obtained by search through internet and by sending emails to state departments of education. Ten randomly selected combined parents were given an independent rater along with the list of editing steps from the readability manual

calculation. The Flesh Grade level {Flesh, 1974} is used to calculate the parents right document. Result indicated that only 4% to 8% of parents right documents were written at the recommended reading level These findings suggests that parents of students with special needs are likely to find parents right documents very difficult to read and understand. Parents right documents should be rewritten to make them accessible to more parents.

1.1 Significance and Scope of the Study

The disabled children whether it is visual impairment, hearing impairment, mental retardation, physically handicapped have feelings Emotion loco motor and multiple disability common to other normal children in general along with the common characteristics, there are specific characteristics or handicap, conditions that warrant special services in their education programs for equalization of educational of opportunities to these children. Them there so many special services which are provided for these children in different special education settings. Trough impotence of training program but still they are not able to avail it because pf lack of awareness. Parents are not aware about these services and the different programs and schemes which are specially made for their benefit.

Parents of children with disability have been the most influential factors in the special education and the delivery of service to children with disabilities throughout the history of special education as per the IDEA Act {1975} parents should have of significant role in education program of children with special needs. In India the parent's movement has started as early as 1968 Headband, gujrat, state, followed by another in 1978 in Bangalore, Karnataka state there are 150, parent association as reheated in 13 National parent's meet of the parents of children. With intellectual disability organized by national institute for the mentally handicapped at combater on 12-13 nov.2005. recent national and international declarations and the biwaco millennium framework for action has also stressed the need for parents and community support which are complimentary to each other for the disability rehabilitation {Rao, 2004} the habilitation and for rehabilitation of the disabled child should, In fact Start from the family. Few studies have been conducted on creating awareness among parents regarding special education services different area. There for there is need to carry out farther research in parental awareness program the parents study focus on creating awareness among parents of children with disabilities about special education services available.
